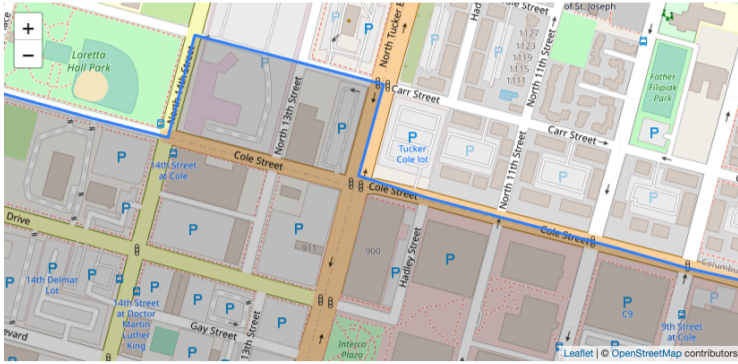

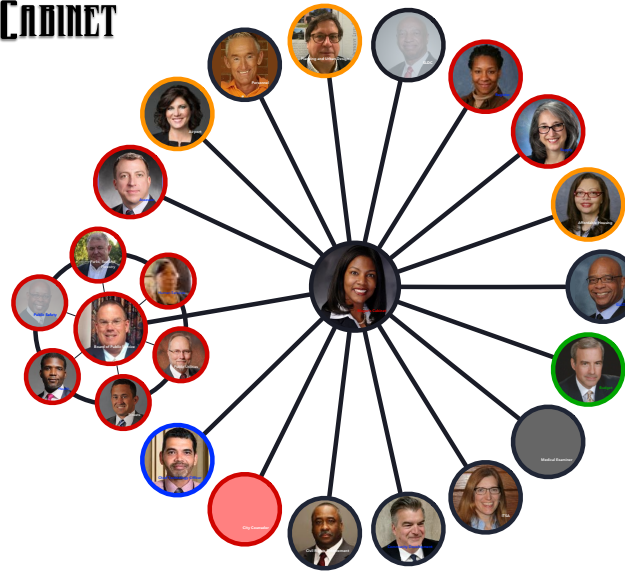


Mayoral Appointments per City Charter
